



Requirements for Port of Entry Visa (Tourist Visa): Section 11(1) – 90 days or Less

*(For Foreigners who Intend To Conduct Short Term)

Requirements: (all forms to be completed in black ink)

Please submit your application in the order outlined below:

- **A Printed Copy** of the ‘**Confirmation of Appointment**’.
- **Completed DHA-84** signed by applicant.
- **Machine Readable Valid Passport** with minimum two (2) unused visa label pages. Passport must be valid for minimum 30 days after the intended date of departure from South Africa.
- **Non-Refundable** Application Fee (if applicable) in the form of a money order/cashier’s check: **\$55.00**
- Two (2) passport photos.
- A Certified/Notarized copy bio page of your passport.
- A Certified/Notarized copy of valid Proof of Residence in the USA (Green Card/H1 B/J1/L1 etc) (Proof of Residence must be valid for duration of stay in South Africa) *(B1/B2 USA visa holders are not eligible to apply in WDC and must apply in your Country of Residence).*
- A Certified/Notarized Unabridged Birth Certificate.
- A pre-paid, self-addressed mailing label and envelope for the return of your passport after processing. **Prepaid Return Envelope Requirements:**
 - **Single passport:** A5-size envelope
 - **Multiple passports:** A4-size envelopeThe envelope must be **sturdy (padded or cardboard-backed), suitably sized to prevent bending**, and include a **trackable prepaid courier label**. Kindly ensure that the **full return address is clearly indicated**.
- **A Statement or Documentation** detailing the purpose and duration of the visit.

- Proof of **Tentative Travel Itinerary** for round-trip air tickets. ***Do not purchase air tickets prior to obtaining your South African visa.***
- Proof of **Tentative Accommodation**.
- **If hosted by South African Citizen or Permanent Resident**, include the following:
 - A Letter of invitation from Hosts,
 - A certified/notarized copy of their RSA ID document,
 - A copy of Host's proof of residence (in the form of a utility bill, tax receipt, bank statements). duly certified by the South African Police Service.
- **If hosted by a Non-South African**, include the following:
 - A Letter of invitation from Hosts,
 - A certified/notarized copy of their RSA ID document,
 - A copy of Host's proof of residence (in the form of a utility bill, tax receipt, bank statement). duly certified by the South African Police Service.
- **Proof of Financial Means** in the form of bank statements for the last three (3) months, **stamped** by your bank **OR** in the absence of the stamp, a bank-issued verification letter for the account holder.
DO NOT submit statements notarized by public notary, will not be accepted.
- **A Yellow Fever Certificate** is required for applicants traveling through *Yellow Fever Belt* areas en route to South Africa.

For Accompanying Children (18 yrs & under), include the following:

- A certified/notarized copy of the full (unabridged) birth certificate for each child below 18 years.
- Consent letter (affidavit) from the non-accompanying parent or legal guardian, in cases where the child is traveling with only one parent or with another accompanying adult.
- A certified copy of the non-accompanying parent's or legal guardian's passport or identity document.
- Proof of legal custody or sole guardianship, where applicable (e.g., court order).
- Adoption papers, where applicable.

Processing Time: 7 -10 business days.
